Camp Rules & Policies

- By submitting a registration form, you have agreed to abide by the campground rules and the teachings according to the Message of the Hour.
- All registered campers must stay on the campgrounds during the entire length of camp
- No camper is to leave the grounds without receiving permission from administrative staff*
- Children 8 years old and younger must have adult supervision at all times
- Campers must stay in their assigned rooms between 12am and 7am
- Unless married or family, no two members of the opposite sex are to be alone unsupervised at any time.
- *Attire*:
 - All campers are required to wear appropriate attire and shoes while outside of sleeping quarters
 - Males:
 - No shorts, skinny jeans or torn/damaged jeans
 - No baggy jeans
 - Wear a belt as necessary
 - No inappropriate graphic tees
 - Females:
 - Modest, loose-fitting dresses or skirts are to be worn when outside of sleeping quarters
 - No tight, clingy or form-fitting skirts or dresses
 - Skirts and dresses must be below the knee when sitting
 - Leggings may be worn under dress or skirt but dress/skirt must be below the knee
 - Modest sleeves and necklines
 - No shorts, slacks
 - No sheer/see-through clothing
- All posts to social media should be appropriate
- All electronic devices (such as cell phones, tablets, etc.) must be turned off or on silent during service times
- Campers must remain in designated dormitory areas at all times. (I.e. males should not be in the area of the female dormitories and vice versa) *
- If any damage occurs to the camp property, the responsible party will be required to pay for the repairs
- Campers are required to attend all scheduled activities and services
- Campers are responsible for checking lost and found before leaving the campground
- All vehicles must be registered for identification purposes
- Gaming electronics, cigarettes, vaping devices, alcohol, recreational drugs, knives, guns and/or other weapons are not permitted*
- The use of scooters and golf carts are to be used by security and medical staff only
- The loss of any room keys will incur a fee of \$30, payable to Gunter Camp & Conference Center
- Jesus Christ Tabernacle and Gunter Camp & Conference Center are not responsible for any stolen items or property

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

We kindly ask that all campers adhere to camp rules

All rules notated with an asterick (*) are zero tolerance rules and disciplinary action will be strictly enforced.

Non-adherence to camp rules will require discussion with Pastor Charles Anderson and head of JCT Camp security team.

Disciplinary action will require contact with camper's parent(s), camper's pastor and can include immediate dismissal from camp property.

Additional Information

- The camp property and daytime activities are for registered (paid) campers only
 - The campground is open to the public for evening services and Sunday morning service
- The campground will provide bedding but you are welcome to bring your own
 - (Couples room: king-sized; Dormitory: twin-sized)
 - You will be charged for camp property bedding that is taken
- Please adhere to property management signage posted on lodging facility doors (especially instructions prior to departure)
- Log Cabin (Welcome Center)
 - Lost and found bin will be located here
 - Iron and ironing board will be available for use (please unplug after use)
- Nurse's Station is located in Pelham Room 13
 - If no one is present, please call the number posted on the door or request assistance from the nearest staff member
- The concessions stand will be open between lunch and dinner and after evening service
 - Smores, pizza and nachos will be sold after evening service
 - Please bring debit/credit card, change or small dollar bills (dollar bills greater than \$20 cannot be accepted)
- If you have left anything or need assistance, please ask your assigned dorm leader or staff member

DAY OF ARRIVAL:

- We ask that campers arrive between 1-3pm on Thursday, June 4th (unless other arrangements have been made)
 - We kindly ask that only staff members and volunteers arrive at designated staff check-in time
- Upon arrival, you will be directed to the Log Cabin (Welcome Center), where registration staff will assist you to:
 - Check-in
 - Receive room assignment and room key (Dorm leaders will be given assigned dormitory keys)
 - You will be given a colored wristband. This must not be removed until camp is over
 - Pick up team T-shirt. THIS SHIRT IS TO BE WORN ON SATURDAY
 - Parking pass (for vehicles left on the property)
- Camp staff will assist you with parking and navigating camp property

Day Campers:

- If you are a day camper for Friday and/or Saturday, you can arrive from 8:30-9:30am for breakfast.
- Please arrive no later than 9:00am and check-in at the log cabin.
- We have reserved rooms for those who need to shower and change before services. (You will need to bring your own towels and toiletries)
- Please return room key to check-in staff before leaving the property. (You will be responsible for paying the fee if key is lost)
- Day campers must abide by all camp rules.
